## Leading the Inclusion of EAL Learners in Post-Primary Schools



The PDST Post Primary EAL team invite teachers with a specific remit for EAL to our workshop that will support those leading the inclusion of EAL learners in a post-primary setting. It will provide a practical overview of how EAL learners' priority needs and language needs can be met by a school. It will explore how teachers with a specific remit for EAL can support mainstream classroom teachers and school leadership in the areas of EAL teaching, learning, assessment and leadership.

## This workshop aims to support teachers with a specific remit for EAL in

- fostering a collaborative approach at the whole school level, the mainstream classroom level and language support level.
- identifying strategies and resources to support EAL learners' social and emotional skills.
- identifying useful tools and resources that can support EAL learners in all subjects.
- embedding EAL assessments within a post-primary school setting.
- identifying EAL learners' needs using assessment materials linked to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- considering the level of support that each EAL learner requires in the context of the Continuum of Support.
- setting relevant targets for EAL learners to help them develop proficiency in English.
- linking language support with the curriculum.
