Oide Droichead Induction Associates

Primary and Post-primary

Oide is a new Department of Education (DE) funded support service for schools, teachers and school leaders which was established on the 1st of September 2023 from the integration of four existing support services. These were the Centre for School Leadership (CSL), Junior Cycle for Teachers (JCT), the National Induction Programme for Teachers (NIPT) and the Professional Development Service for Teachers (PDST). Oide may have a number of opportunities for the position of Associate for 2024.2025.

An Oide Droichead Induction Associate is a registered school principal, deputy principal, teacher, or a former school principal, deputy principal or teacher, who is engaged to work in a part-time capacity with Oide to complement and extend the capacity of the service. Droichead Induction associates will be required to make themselves available to work for **up to 20 days** in any one year, with most work happening outside of school time. However, appointment as an associate does not guarantee 20 days' work in any given year.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified primary and post-primary candidates who are fully registered with the Teaching Council, hold a recognised position in a school and ideally have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience. Retired teachers and teachers on career break are also eligible to apply (subject to DE guidelines). Candidates with practical experience of the Droichead process are particularly welcome.

Following the application process, shortlisted candidates will be invited to a face-to-face recruitment event (which includes a group interview) in a central location on **Saturday, 27th April 2024.**

After the event, a panel will be created for 2024.2025. Oide Droichead Induction Associate positions will be offered to panel members based on the needs of the organisation at national and regional levels. Please note that a place on the panel does not guarantee work as an associate.
